

Main Match 4 stage Pistol per day \$70 Sat/ \$70 Sun Wranglers per day \$15 Sat/\$15 Sun 2 Stage Rifle \$40 Sat

2 Stage Shotgun \$35 Sat

Jackpot per day \$20 Sat/\$20 Sun 100% payback (1/3 or 1/4 split depending on number of riders)
Clean Shooter Pot per day \$5 Sat/\$5 Sun (100% payback split among ALL clean shooters)
Partner Up Saturday and Sunday \$10 per rider. Lower-level rider randomly paired with upper-level rider. Based on overall results.
